Overview of the project activities and results

The objective of the project was to exchange experience among the partner organizations, which all have experience in the implementation of activities and projects aiming at the promotion of Roma inclusion, including in the inclusion of Roma children in the education. The project facilitated the exchange of experience and good practices between the partner organizations regarding the national developments in Roma inclusion in education, as well as tools and methods which they applied and/or implemented and achieved positive results.

The project activities implemented were as follows:

Work Package 1: Exchange of best practices and pilot testing of tools & methods for Roma inclusive education

- Organization of transnational project meetings (virtual as well as in person);
- Organization of study visits in the 3 countries;
- Elaboration of criteria for the selection of good practices;
- Elaboration and selection of good practices implemented by the partner organizations;
- Online seminar in exchanging information on the methodology used by each partner for the implementation of their tools, methods and practices;
- Pilot testing of tools, methods and practices in all 3 countries.



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Work Package 2: Report on “Transnational experiences and lessons learnt from the local implementation of activities for the promotion of Roma inclusive education”

- Organization of an online workshop for discussing the outcomes and the methodology for documenting the outcomes of the pilot;
- Production of the Report “Transnational experiences and lessons learnt from the local implementation of activities for the promotion of Roma inclusive education”.



Work Package 3: Dissemination of the project’s results

- Production and dissemination of e-newsletters and the project's e-brochure;
- Organization of a final dissemination event;
- Distribution of the Report to relevant authorities, agencies and organizations.

Outputs of the project:

- 15 transnational project meetings organized;
- 10 good practices of Roma inclusion in education proposed by the partner organizations to be piloted;
- 3 good practices of Roma inclusion in education piloted in the 3 countries;
- 3 study visits organized (1 in Greece, 1 in Bulgaria and 1 in Romania);
- 1 online seminar for exchanging information on the methodology used by each partner for the implementation of their tools and methods organized;
- Questionnaires and interview outline for collecting feedback from the participants in the project pilot activity designed;
- Interviews with persons benefited indirectly by the project pilot activity conducted;
- Questionnaires filled in by the participants in the project pilot activity;
- Evaluation of the pilot activity conducted by teachers, students and parents;
- 1 online workshop for discussing the outcomes of the pilot activity and the methodology for presenting them in the Report organized;
- 1 Report presenting the outcomes of the pilot and summarizing the experiences of the partner organizations drafted;
- The Report distributed to relevant authorities and organizations;



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- 1 final dissemination event (conference) organized;
- 7 e-newsletters produced;
- 1 e-brochure produced.



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
